

## Summary of Chapter minutes September 2020 by Zoom

- The Congregation had been informed of a Vestry Meeting by Zoom at 4pm on Thursday 22 October. Guidance from the Church in Wales was that the full update of the Electoral Roll would be deferred until 2022.
- The accounts would now need to be finalised for approval by Chapter and for presentation at the Vestry Meeting.
- The Cathedral could be eligible for Welsh Government grant for heritage activities because of the pandemic. A sub group of Chapter will meet to consider this and prepare the online application.
- The August and September management accounts were reviewed and the Canon Treasurer reported that good progress had been made in generating savings and additional income, with further actions in hand which need to be concluded if the Cathedral was to operate within its policy for the minimum level of free reserves.
- Following the request from the Cathedral School to use the Parish Hall for teaching during the pandemic, Heads of Terms had been drawn up and circulated.
- The door of Prebendal House is being painted Llandaff Cathedral blue, by the Saturday working group. The DAC had made a recommendation on the material for the recoating of the porch.
- Work on Eco Church had been taken forward with discussions about management of the churchyard with the local Wildlife Trust. Keep Wales Tidy have awarded the Cathedral a starter pack for a 'Butterfly garden' which is to be installed in October.
- Services were running close to capacity currently. Two choristers had sung at the 11am Eucharist on 13 September, and it was hoped that there could be a small choir by the first Sunday in October. Consideration was being given to a weekday service and a Sunday afternoon service.
- The Precentor and the Director of Music had had constructive meetings with the School and the conductor of the girls' choir.
