CHORAL EUCHARIST INTERCESSIONS TEAM Role Description and Person Specification

ROLE

• To lead the Choral Eucharist congregation in Intercessions.

TIME

• One Choral Eucharist service on Sunday every 10 to 12 weeks (about four times a year) plus time beforehand at home to consider, compose and rehearse the script.

WHO

• Anyone who wishes to contribute directly to worship and, as a result, potentially deepen their own faith and understanding. It is unlikely that any disability would prevent volunteering.

SKILLS

- A liturgical awareness.
- Ability to prepare a script based on a given Intercessions template.
- An awareness of the Eucharist readings of the day which may offer a theme.
- A broad awareness of current national, diocesan, parish and Cathedral affairs which may from time to time be included in Intercessions.
- The knack of anticipating what the congregation would hope to say themselves.
- Confidence to deliver the script from the lectern.

TRAINING

- Full guidance notes will be provided prior to considering joining the team. They include suggestions of books and publications offering source material.
- The lay team leader will give broad advice and help on request and the clergy will advise on liturgical detail.
- The Diocesan Cycle of Prayer details as well as names on the lists of the Sick, Recently Departed or Year's Mind are published online on Saturday in the Weekly Notes and overnight updates will be on the lectern or given by the clergy on Sunday morning.
- The Readings are circulated monthly in advance.
- Occasional training meetings will be planned.
