Parish Stewards

Who: People who are friendly, polite, and have a courteous nature.

People who can be available for a minimum of 9 Sundays a year. People who are physically able to open West Door and South Door.

People who like to work as part of a team.

People who are mindful of the needs and safety of others

What skills:

Vision & planning skills
Good communication skills
To be practical and organised

To keep up with safeguarding matters

An awareness of the Cathedral's layout

Training:

Monthly briefings to the stewards on duty for the that month detailing their roles and occasional Parish Stewards meeting.

Role:

Working as a team with other stewards, to ensure the safety of the congregation and to assist in the smooth running of the service. The Parish Stewards are also crucial in creating a positive experience for visitors and the congregation at the Parish services. Assisting with tidying the nave after Sunday services.

Time commitment:

Typically 9 Sundays a year, starting 30 minutes before the service and ending 15 minutes after the service, 8.30am to 10.15am at the Parish Eucharist service.
