Event Stewards

Who: People who are friendly, polite, and have a courteous nature.

People who can be available to steward events in the evenings and/or weekends.

People who are physically able to open West Door and South Door.

People who like to work as part of a team.

People who are mindful of the needs and safety of others

What skills:

Good awareness of what is happening around them.

Good communication skills

To be practical and organised

An awareness of the Cathedral's layout

Training: Meeting prior to each event to ensure that in the event of a fire, those attending the event can be evacuated quickly and safely. Those new to the role will be shown how to open the West and South doors and be given a briefing document that details the role of an Event Steward (Fire Marshall).

Role: Working as a team with other event stewards, to ensure the safety of the event goers. The event steward's role is primarily to act as a Fire Marshall and help to evacuate the Cathedral in the event of the fire. The event organiser is responsible for seating and ticketing of the event goers and to tidy the Cathedral after the event.

Time commitment: As availability allows, or once a month. Events typically start at 7pm and close at 10pm. Event stewards meet 30min prior to the start of the event for a briefing. The majority of events are held during the evening on weekdays and on Saturdays.
