We prepare ourselves for the crucifixion of Christ, his dying for our sins, and his Resurrection on Easter Day.

## Lent Appeal Charity 2024

Selected from a shortlist compiled by the Llandaff Cathedral Community Council, Embrace the Middle East works with Christians in the region to address poverty and injustice, working with their partners to provide vital services to those at risk of marginalisation and exclusion. ## Choral Eucharist with the Imposition of Ashes

7.30pm | Wednesday 14th February

This solemn celebration of the Holy Eucharist marks the start of the season of Lent. During the service, we are marked on the forehead with ash made from the palms of the previous year, a sign of our mortality. It is this practice that gives Ash Wednesday its name.
