During the service, Bishop Mary will also be installing the Rev'd Anne-Marie Renshaw as Archdeacon of Morgannwg. Anne-Marie joins the Diocese from the Benefice of Thurstable & Winstree in the Diocese of Chelmsford, where she is currently the Team Rector.

Christian Aid Call to Prayer – Christian Aid is calling for churches across the UK to pray for peace in Gaza following appeals for solidarity from Palestinian church leaders. A day of prayer takes place on Sunday 21st September to coincide with UN World Peace Day and the global call to prayer from the World Council of Churches. On Wednesday 24th September, Christian Aid, Embrace the Middle East and other Christian charities and organisations are holding a peaceful public prayer and witness outside the Senedd at 12.30.
