Help the Cathedral while shopping online! - All the leading supermarkets, including Tesco, Morrisons, ASDA, Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Iceland, and Ocado will give free donations to the Cathedral when you order online from them via EasyFundraising, at no extra cost. In most cases, supermarkets offer a flat donation amount of up to £6 per online order and others offer a percentage based on how much is spent. Just two people could generate £114 of unrestricted funding in a year by doing their regular food shop.

First Holy Communion on Advent Sunday, Sunday 30th **November** – If you are in Year 4, 5 or 6 and have signed up to be prepared to receive Holy Communion for the first time, please attend the 9 o'clock Sunday School and Services on Sunday 16th and 23rd November. You should return the online form as soon as possible.

Cardiff Food Bank – Thank you to everyone who contributed so generously to our Harvest Appeal. We filled 14 crates with donated food, and to this can be added cash and cheque donations, many of which were Gift Aided. The Foodbank will give us detailed results shortly, but in the meantime thank you once again for your contributions – the need for Foodbanks continues to increase, and your support is so valuable in helping some of the most needy individuals and families in our local community.

Mothers' Union – Our next meeting is on Monday 20th October at 2.00pm in the Parish Hall. We will be welcoming our speaker Rev'd Canon Graham Holcombe. Visitors are always warmly welcome to attend our meetings.

Visiting Bellringers – We are pleased to welcome a band of visiting ringers from Northamptonshire who will be spending about a week in South Wales. They will be here at Llandaff Cathedral on Saturday 25th October and will be attempting to ring a peal between 10am and 2pm. We wish them every success.

UN World Peace Day – Sunday 21st September was UN World Peace Day, on which the World Council of Churches issued a global call to prayer and witness in solidarity with all those affected by the violence in the Middle East. Here in Wales, Members of the Senedd, senior church leaders, churchgoers from many denominations and representatives from Christian Aid, Embrace the Middle East and CAFOD met outside the Senedd on 24th September for a vigil organised by Christian Aid Cymru. The Archbishop of Wales was among those who addressed the gathering, and this was followed by prayer and a period of silent witness. It was a powerful and moving expression of solidarity in response to the suffering of so many in the ongoing crisis in Gaza and the West Bank.
