Winter Craft Fair – We're collecting bottles for our ever-popular tombola at the Winter Craft Fair on Tuesday 25th November, and anything goes, from sparkling water to sparkling wine! Bellringing – On Saturday 8th November, The Most Reverend Cherry Vann will be enthroned as Archbishop of Wales at Newport Cathedral. Before the 3.00pm service a group of 12 ringers, including 3 from Llandaff Cathedral, will ring a celebratory quarter peal to mark the occasion.

Meanwhile, Sunday 9th November is Remembrance Sunday. In keeping with tradition, Llandaff Cathedral bells will be rung half muffled before the 10.50am service. Members of the congregation may notice that the bells sound difference, with louder notes followed by softer ones, like a mournful echo.

Mothers Union – Our next meeting will be in the Parish Hall at 2.00pm on Monday 3rd November. Paula Massey will talk to us about the work of the charity 'Guardian for Heroes'. Names will be taken for members who would like to come to our Autumn Lunch in Porro on Monday 1st December. As usual, visitors are most welcome to attend our meeting.
