Advent Appeal – The Cathedral's Advent Appeal 2025 is For Age Connects, a local charity committed to tackling loneliness, isolation and poverty amongst older people. It works to make ageing a positive experience for everyone and to support older people and their families at a difficult time of their life. The Appeal opens on Advent Sunday, 30th November, and collections will be made after all the main services on the two following Sundays. Further details will follow shortly. Help the Cathedral while shopping online! - All the leading supermarkets, including **Tesco, Morrisons, ASDA, Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Iceland**, and **Ocado** will give free donations to the Cathedral when you order online from them via EasyFundraising, at no extra cost. In most cases, supermarkets offer a flat donation amount of **up to £6** per online order and others offer a percentage based on how much is spent. **Just two people could generate £114 of unrestricted funding in a year by doing their regular food shop.**
