Christian Aid Week 2026 – Preparations for Christian Aid Week, which takes place from 10th-16th May, are now underway. Lent Appeal Final result – Almost! With only a small amount of money yet to come in, we can report that the Lent Appeal for Wales Air Ambulance has raised over £1,778 from a variety of fund-raising activities: the bucket collection, the Pancake Party, the Sunday School Project and the Choir Bakesale. To this can be added over £1,097 from a bucket collection at the Meatloaf concert, giving a very pleasing total of £2,875. We estimate that about £700 of the Cathedral donations were Gift Aided, bringing a further benefit of £175 to the Charity. A very big Thank You to everyone who helped to achieve this excellent result; the absolutely final result will be posted on the Charities Table as soon as it is available. *The Charities Subcommittee.*
