This service is developing a following and everyone is most welcome to attend.

**Lent Appeal 2026 for Wales Air Ambulance** – The bucket collection in aid of our Lent Charity is now complete, and has raised the very pleasing sum of £1,016. A further £155 has been donated online, making an interim total of £1,171. The bucket collection is only one source of the Cathedral’s fund-raising, and there is plenty more still to come, including the proceeds of the Pancake Party, the Sunday School’s Lent and Easter projects and the Cathedral Choir’s Bake Sale. The final result of the Appeal will be available after Easter, meantime a big Thank You to everyone who has contributed so generously, and please watch this space for further information as soon as the full figures are available.
