All are welcome, including children: there is plenty of space to run around in the garden, and strawberries and home-made cakes are guaranteed for adults and children alike. Summer Concert Series – Wednesdays @ 7.30pm - Join us on **Wednesday 13 May** for the start of this year's Summer Concert Series. The first concert will be performed by our own Assistant Director of Music, Aaron Shilson, whose programme will include works by J. S. Bach, Iain Farrington, as well as two works by French organist Maurice Duruflé as we mark 40 years since his death. Other performers will include Matthew McVey (Assistant Director of Music, Brecon Cathedral) and our own Director of Music, Stephen Moore.

Compassion Fatigue? It's unfortunate that every year, Advent, Lent and Christian Aid Week come hard on each other's heels, and having given so generously in Advent and Lent, you may be reluctant to do it all over again in Christian Aid Week.
