Bellringing for Mothers' Union Anniversary – The Cathedral Bellringers will dedicate their morning ringing on Sunday 9th August (before the 11am service) to honour Mary Sumner Day, the 150th anniversary of the Mothers' Union. Our treble bell was the gift of the Llandaff Diocesan Mothers' Union in its centenary year and bears the inscription "*Inter Omnes Pax – Bridget – Llandaff Diocesan Mothers' Union – 1893-1993*".

This is the same inscription ("Peace among all men") as on the smaller of the two bells which escaped sale of 1763, and which had been given to All Saints Church, Llandaff North, in 1890. On 2nd January 1941, All Saints Church was lost to a fire bomb and its bell, cast by William & Evan Evans of Chepstow in 1727, was destroyed.

Majestas Kids - Majestas Kids is a fun and welcoming music group for children aged 7–13, led by Cathedral Animateur Rachel Kilby. It's a great opportunity for young people to develop vocal skills, learn to read music through singing and games, build confidence, make friends, and take part in exciting performances throughout the year.

The new term begins on Wednesday 16th September and we meet weekly during term time on Wednesdays from 4–5.30pm at the Cathedral. Throughout the year, members have the opportunity to perform at a range of Cathedral events and services, including the Christmas Fayre, Crib Service, Evensong, and the Cathedral Choirs' Concert.

Membership costs £25 per term or £60 for the full year. Regular attendance is important as we rehearse towards performances and special events. No previous singing experience is required. Everyone is welcome.
