Doors open at 6.30pm with the event starting at 7.00pm, and our Bar will be open throughout.

Bellringing for Mothers' Union Anniversary – The Cathedral Bellringers will dedicate their morning ringing on Sunday 9th August (before the 11am service) to honour Mary Sumner Day, the 150th anniversary of the Mothers' Union. Our treble bell was the gift of the Llandaff Diocesan Mothers' Union in its centenary year and bears the inscription *"Inter Omnes Pax – Bridget – Llandaff Diocesan Mothers' Union – 1893-1993"*. This is the same inscription ("Peace among all men") as on the smaller of the two bells which escaped sale of 1763, and which had been given to All Saints Church, Llandaff North, in 1890. On 2nd January 1941, All Saints Church was lost to a fire bomb and its bell, cast by William & Evan Evans of Chepstow in 1727, was destroyed.
