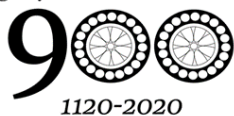

Lent Lunch – Thank you to all those who have volunteered to organise the Lunches this year. Please note that the Lent Lunch will be on Tuesdays in Lent, preceded by the Eucharist which will be at 12 noon (instead of 10.00 am) for the duration of the season. The first Lunch is on Tuesday 3rd March.

Lent Appeal 2020 - the focus of this year's Lent Appeal will be the *Church in Wales Centenary Fund*. This has been launched to support two charities – one at home, and one overseas – to mark 100 years of the Church in Wales. The Appeal aims to raise at least £100,000 over the next five years for Housing Justice Cymru and Christian Aid. Envelopes will be available as usual from the beginning of Lent.
