



Llandaff Cathedral Engagement, Mission and Education Committee

Terms of Reference

Objectives

To contribute to the Cathedral's mission and ministry in the areas of pastoral care, education, visitor experience, community engagement and outreach. Members will advise, encourage, support and seek to resource these parts of Cathedral life.

Pastoral care: includes support of volunteers as well as individual pastoral care of congregation members.

Education: includes school visits, adult guided tours, and nurture of congregations eg through courses and groups.

Visitor experience includes the quality of welcome and hospitality, and information provided for visitors eg online, in print, on interpretive signage in the Cathedral.

Community Engagement and outreach includes outward facing activities, eg involvement of Cathedral members in local volunteering, developing stronger links between Cathedral and Diocese, and developing the Eco Church agenda.

Reporting to Chapter

The committee will report to Chapter following each meeting. Where a new initiative is planned, especially one requiring financial support, the committee will draw up a recommendation to put forward to Chapter.

Frequency of meetings:

Initially the committee will meet 6 times per annum.
